Here's how you can help - Join our Fundraising team

Event Fundraisers

Can choose from a varied range of ways to help from participating in Branch fundraising events such as our Annual Summer Fayre; or our Dog Shows or attend other Organiser's Events with our own stall to fundraise, either by selling merchandise or running prize winning games eg. a Cuddly Toy Tombola

- Merchandise Stalls may include selling bought in goods such as, RSPCA logo'd goods Costume jewellery; Pet products; Christmas cards and gifts (seasonal); Stock especially collected from our shops. Sell Homemade Cakes* etc.
- Prize winning Stalls, could include a Tombola , Adopt A Cuddly Pet; Kiddies Lucky Dips, Hook a Duck; Treasure Map Hunt etc.
- "Behind the Scenes" Fundraising. Assisting in running competitions eg. Pet photo competitions. Processing of on-line sales. Helping to raise sponsorship or free prizes for events.

Willing to bake cakes, biscuits, etc to donate to our Cake Stalls. Preparing other food and refreshments for events. *Servers willing to help on Refreshments & Food stalls.

Fundraising Team Leaders

Are needed to take responsibility for an event on the day to ensure other volunteers know what they're doing; oversee the whole event from set-up to take down. Completing any paperwork at the end eg. Stock-takes.
